- 1 to putting basically two options to your Minister.
- Option one: "That if federal assistance is to be granted,
- 3 it would be necessary to do a variety of things." And
- 4 you list them there. And it basically repeats the point
- 5 you've been making.
- 6 And then Option two: "If it's your intention that
- 7 federal assistance not be provided..." et cetera, et
- 8 cetera. You were pressing, I take it, for a decision at
- 9 that time for which way to go rather than just continuing
- 10 to study it or keep it boiling on the back burner?
- 11 A. Yes, although it must be made clear that my
- 12 Minister, in providing the direction, is not making the
- decision. He's providing the direction to proceed with a
- 14 -- in a particular fashion to seek Cabinet approval.
- 15 Q. Did he give you a decision at that time?
- 16 A. [No audible response]
- 17 O. I noted in --
- 18 A. I honestly can't remember. I suspect it was Option
- one because that's what we did.
- 20 Q. All right.
- 21 A. I honestly can't remember on that specific document
- 22 O. All right. So that's June 1st, '88.
- 23 If you can turn to the next document, it's a memo
- July the 11th, '88, and, again, from you to your
- 25 Minister. It may have been a draft because it's
