1 point in time, the latter part of 1988 the discussion and  
2 the analysis of this application basically did come down  
3 to focus on these six points, essentially? They were the

5 A. They were part of -- they were still the -- Curragh  
6 was still arguing about the level of support, so we had  
7 other fish in the fire here, or in the pan.

8 Q. Yes, all right. There are two attachments that came  
9 to us with the documents that would have been part of  
10 those minutes, and I don't expect your memory to ask you  
11 if they were in fact attached to those minutes, but I  
12 assume that they would have contained the kind of  
13 information that was being discussed in that meeting?

14 A. Yeah, as I recall -- I can't recall whether they  
15 were presented at that meeting or whether they were  
16 attached to the letter of October 28th, but certainly in  
17 one or the other, both of which are in the public record,  
18 these documents have surfaced.

19 Q. All right. Let me turn you now to the next document  
20 which is a memo from a Meredith Filshie to a D.S.  
21 McPhail, dated October the 27th. And just a couple of  
22 quick points at -- I want to get your assistance on. On  
23 the first page, middle of the page under "Westray/DEVCO,"  
24 second paragraph -- actually, the first paragraph helps  
25 because it recites the fact that, "Yesterday morning
