1 MR. COLIN CAMPBELL And I wanted to try to bring that
2 out.

3 COMMISSIONER -- unforeseen maintenance, basically.

4 MR. COLIN CAMPBELL Yes.

5 COMMISSIONER Which halts production. Yeah, okay.

6 MR. MERRICK Mr. Rogers, one other just point of
7 clarification coming out of this morning. You had made
8 reference to the fact of the initial review done by
9 CANMET under tight time constraints. And then you said
10 that you had understood that they had done a follow-up
11 evaluation sometime later. Did you have an opportunity
12 over the noon break to clarify that?

13 A. Yes, I did. What I read last night was some
14 documentation that I had not seen before and that that
15 documentation appeared to attach to it a series of
16 documents under a 1989 date from CANMET to the Province
17 of Nova Scotia which, in fact, was a mixture of documents
18 improperly attached. And so what appeared to be analyses
19 that were done subsequent to 1988 were indeed analyses
20 that were done in 1988. So I'm pleased to have the
21 chance to correct that with you.

22 Q. So that to the best of your information, CANMET did
23 not do any sort of a general or in detail further
24 evaluation of this project subsequent to their initial
25 one?
