- 1 A. Amongst others.
- Q. Amongst others. All right. Let's -- so it looks at
- 3 this point, I take it, as if the deal is in place?
- 4 A. This is December 1989. In six more months, there is
- 5 a deal in place.
- 6 Q. Yeah, all right. And that just goes to show that
- 7 nothing is for sure until it's for sure?
- 8 A. No.
- 9 Q. Let's pick up some of the other problems. If you
- turn over to page 75. this is a memo from Mr. Russell.
- 11 He would be the Executive Director of ACOA?
- 12 A. No, he was my Regional Director in Nova Scotia.
- 13 Q. I follow you.
- 14 A. Department of I.S.T.C.
- 15 Q. All right. So he now is sending you a memo. And I
- 16 see in the middle of the first page under "Background,"
- 17 he says, "The Halifax office received comments from
- 18 Environment Canada concerning this project. In an
- 19 appendix, Environment Canada advised us that the burning
- of Westray coal at Trenton will not allow the generating
- 21 station to meet the thermal power emissions guidelines
- 22 recently applied to either new power plants in the
- 23 region." What was that all about? Was that connected to
- 24 one of those earlier issues that Minister Cameron raised
- or is this another one -- another issue again?
