- 1 settlement of the terms, the agreement could take some
- 2 time." I got the impression from all of this that this
- 3 now was causing a problem with the Westray agreement.
- 4 Can you help me on that?
- 5 A. Not a great deal. It was, as I recall, when these
- 6 came in, and Boutilier had taken this action, I kind of
- 7 smiled and said, "Well, gee, that was smart." But -- and
- 8 if he can do it, fine, but it wasn't, as I said, really
- 9 related to the contract with Westray, as we had, I
- 10 thought, good and sufficient commitment on the record. I
- 11 think what was happening was that others were catching up
- 12 with the -- including Roy Sherwood, with the status of
- 13 something that they didn't know.
- 14 And I certainly wasn't phoning all over the place to
- tell people what my position was or what the position was
- that was going to be forwarded to Ministers for decision.
- 17 I mean, I don't -- that's not -- we do that when we get
- 18 our documentation completed. So I think this is just a
- representation of people not in the loop, being out of
- 20 phase.
- 21 Q. All right, that may be a good mid-afternoon break,
- 22 Mr. Commission.
