- 1 <u>COMMISSIONER</u> That's all you're entitled to anyway, so
- 2 that's no big deal.
- 3 MR. TRAVES Then I shouldn't have a problem.
- 4 <u>COMMISSIONER</u> Mr. Hebert?
- 5 MR. HEBERT I had indicated that we would probably
- 6 take up the 15 minutes or whatever we were allowed.
- 7 <u>COMMISSIONER</u> Well, they're up to an hour.
- 8 MR. COLIN CAMPBELL Okay. Well, then -- we made [an
- 9 attempt?] That's fine.
- 10 <u>COMMISSIONER</u> And then Mr. Merrick, of course, would
- 11 have the opportunity to redirect, eh?
- 12 MR. COLIN CAMPBELL That's fine.
- 13 COMMISSIONER Yeah.
- 14 <u>EXAMINATION BY THE COMMISSIONER</u>
- 15 Q. I want to ask you one question before we close off
- 16 this afternoon. It would be very brief, but it's -- and
- 17 it's very general. In your experience and in your
- 18 opinion as a senior Federal bureaucrat, would you say
- that an \$80 million investment or an \$80 million
- 20 commitment in a project such as this by the Federal
- 21 Government would constitute a significant Federal
- involvement in a project?
- 23 A. If it was -- if it was a project that the government
- was going to manage directly in the sense of a
- 25 contribution agreement, it would be significant.
