4 Q. All right. And were you -- was your Department  
5 provided with the documentation which was filed with the  
6 bank for their loan applications?

7 A. Oh, yes, of course. We were party to the contracts.

8 Q. All right. You were par -- I understand you were  
9 party to contracts, but the question was: Did you receive  
10 everything that the bank received?

11 A. Yes, we did.

12 Q. Okay. And how were you aware of that? Were you  
13 getting the documentation from the bank or from Curragh?

14 A. The documentation was all available at the signing  
15 of the contracts, which, as I think I've mentioned, is  
16 some five feet of documentation.

17 Q. Okay.

18 A. And all of those were available sim -- all the  
19 documentation was available simultaneously to the bank,  
20 to Curragh, and to the Government of Canada.

21 Q. And who made that documentation available?

22 A. It was made by our legal counsel who, in fact,  
23 executed the contracts on behalf of the Government.

24 Q. All right. So it was your legal counsel that would  
25 have obtained the information from the banks?
