1 And then in paragraph number three she notes what I
2 take to be a point passed on to her on behalf of Curragh:
3 "Westray wants to be subject to existing Mineral
4 Resources Act, i.e., wants to be grandfathered into new
5 Act, but protected from any of its provisions which it
6 feels will negatively affect its operations."
