1 Curragh?

2 A. Many times I said, yes, I think you're right with
3 our staff and they continued to negotiate. Curragh
4 wanted a much better deal; there's no question about
5 that.

6 But I hope you're not leaving the impression that I
7 negotiated the deal. That wouldn't be normal.

8 Q. Let me -- I'm just trying to find out what happened.
9 Let me move on. Turn to page 48 which is the next page.
10 It's another memo from Mr. Phillips. I think we may have
11 looked at this yesterday; I'm not sure. It's dated March
12 5, 1990. He again is reporting to people in his company
13 about an extensive telephone conversation with you that
14 morning. He reports about Mr. Bouchard being the new
15 Minister.

16 He then says over on the next page, paragraph 6:
17 "Last week, Don was given a confidential copy of the
18 Federal government's internal report on the DEVCO
19 operation. Don read from the report's conclusions." Do
20 you recall discussing that report with Mr. Phillips?

21 A. I don't know if there's a confidential -- I don't
22 know what report he's talking about right with that
23 paragraph.

24 Q. So you can't think of any report that might be what
25 he was talking about?
