2 interim loan. And we've talked about that yesterday.

3 A. Um-hmm.

4 Q. Let me take you to another aspect of the negotiating  
5 position by the Province. Mr. Rogers, in his evidence,  
6 said -- in fact, let me read you part of his transcript.  
7 Just let me find it here for a second. Yes, this comes  
8 from page 13424. I had been asking him about --

9 A. Where is it?

10 Q. It's just from his transcript.

11 A. Oh, I see.

12 Q. I'm going to read it to you.

13 A. Okay.

14 Q. I had been asking him about some of the  
15 correspondence that had been passing back and forth and  
16 he was explaining the background to it. And on the  
17 particular document he was describing the communications  
18 back and forth and he said this. He was talking about  
19 the Canada/Nova Scotia agreement on sulphur emissions.  
20 And he says, "The Canada/Nova Scotia agreement on sulphur  
21 emissions targeted levels that would be accomplished at a  
22 certain date. I think it was 129,000 tonnes and the date  
23 was, I think, by 1995 or something in the future."

24 A. 160,000 tonnes.

25 Q. "At a point in the discussion with Minister Cameron,
