1 And what I would like to do is take the other deals done  
2 at that period of time and look at them. So would you  
3 ask the Department for 10 or 10 -- 10 or 15 or 20 of  
4 these deals so we -- or whatever they can give us at that  
5 period of time to see -- to see what we charged in  
6 interest, to see what the terms of repayment was, to see  
7 what percent of the total deal our portion would be."  
8 Now I would think that was pretty important when people  
9 are making these allegations, and Mr. Merrick is saying  
10 this morning that we did nothing. We didn't take a tough  
11 stand. Well, if we had those deals that I asked for, you  
12 would have to say that it would be pretty important to be  
13 able to make that comparison, but --

14 COMMISSIONER Well, you want --

15 A. -- I couldn't get them.

16 COMMISSIONER -- me to put -- to put a cap on this, Mr.  
17 Cameron, the only thing we can do now is wait for a  
18 response from the Government with respect to the specific  
19 request. And if the response is forthcoming in a  
20 positive fashion, then we will factor that into our  
21 evidence.

22 A. Uh-huh.

23 COMMISSIONER That's all I can do.

24 A. Well --

25 COMMISSIONER So we can carry on.
