1 this to finish it off, because I asked you some questions
2 about this yesterday, but I want to make sure I've got
3 everything. Can you direct me to any actions that you
4 took or instructions that you gave your Department
5 officials to canvass what other options may have been
6 available to achieve the low-sulphur standards that you
7 were seeking to achieve?

8 A. There was no question that the Government -- not
9 even ours in back looked at options. The Power
10 Corporation looked at the option of a scrubber, and what
11 they told us was that it would cost too much. And there
12 were a concern about space.

13 Q. And we've got a lot of evidence on that in the
14 documents.

15 A. Yeah.

16 Q. Do you know what actions or efforts were made to
17 canvass any other options?

18 A. I believe they looked at -- even the blending low-
19 sulphur coal from other places.

20 Q. Do you know if they did?

21 A. I believe that they have looked at that in the past,
22 yeah.

23 Q. Do you know if they had looked at bringing in
24 western coal, because we've had some suggestions given to
25 us that western coal could have been brought in cheaper?
