- 1 he said, "You know, we have a contract with the Power
- 2 Corporation and we'd like to produce coal." I thought,
- 3 you know, that was a reasonable proposition. They were
- 4 held up. They had to produce coal by, I think, it was
- 5 mid-1991, and they were going to produce some coal by the
- 6 development -- developing those tunnels north and produce
- 7 the rest in that section of the mine, which was all part
- 8 of the original plan that I saw.
- 9 Q. Tell me what discussion that was. When did it take
- 10 place? What were the circumstances?
- 11 A. What -- which one now?
- 12 O. When he told you that they were going into the
- 13 Southwest because they wanted to produce for this
- 14 contract.
- 15 A. I really don't know. I guess when they changed the
- 16 tunnel direction and went in there. I --
- 17 O. Do you recall having a discussion with him about why
- they were required to go in there?
- 19 A. He -- my recollection is that they wanted to produce
- 20 coal, that they had a contract and they wanted to produce
- 21 coal. I didn't -- it seemed like a reasonable
- 22 explanation to me.
- 23 Q. Was there any other discussion as to the fact that
- they were under pressure, they had to or they were behind
- 25 or ahead or --
