1 look over everyone's shoulder all the time. We will not
2 be able to afford that.

3 And that's where somehow we have to understand when
4 we say that it's got to come from the bottom up, that the
5 prime -- the prime responsibility, the foundation -- the
6 foundation of that new Act I read, it says, "The
7 foundation is the internal responsibility system."

8 And I'm afraid, because of this tragic accident,
9 that we're going to say somehow we can police every
10 worker to make sure -- we have to develop a culture of
11 safe -- a culture of learning in all of our companies.

12 And, yes, there is a role for the Department. And
13 in the new Act, I'm pleased to see that the fines are
14 much, much greater and the jail terms are greater.
15 That's after a great, great deal of study, what people
16 have included. And when you look at those kinds of
17 accidents in a place where you have the constant
18 inspections, you say, "Well, maybe we are jumping to
19 conclusions too fast. And that's the point I want to
20 make.

21 Q. All right. Anything else that you want to give us
22 on -- while we're on that?

23 A. Well, no, I don't think so.

24 Q. Let me ask you a smaller question that still fits in
