1 Q. Now the other -- the "gossip," as you call it and
2 which was touched on this morning was your relationship
3 with Mr. Phillips. And the question I have for you is
4 whether or not you've maintained your contacts with Mr.
5 Phillips to date?

6 A. Yeah, once in awhile. I called Gerald about maybe
7 two weeks ago. I wanted very much to get two letters
8 that were written to the RCMP. I knew that he had them.
9 I wanted those letters, and he refused to give them to
10 me. And I also urged him to come and appear before the
11 Inquiry. I thought it was important that he did.

12 Q. All right. And you indicated twice in your
13 testimony that you understood that he would be coming.
14 Did he indicate that to you?

15 A. Well, no, what I indicated was, after reading the
16 papers, that if he was subpoenaed, he would come, and I
17 understand he has been subpoenaed. So I have not talked
18 to him since then. And I still didn't get the letters.

19 Q. Okay. Did Mr. Phillips or did Curragh or Westray or
20 anyone connected with the company make any contributions
21 to your political campaigns or Party that --

22 A. All I can --

23 Q. -- you're aware of?

24 A. Yeah, all I can do is speak for myself. Absolutely
