3 EXAMINATION BY MR. ROBERTS

4 Q. Mr. Cameron, my name is David Roberts. I represent  
5 the United Steelworkers of America, the certified  
6 bargaining agent of the Westray employees. And I want to  
7 come back to this issue which you raised yesterday in  
8 your opening statement and again referred to it, and that  
9 is the use of the reset button by continuous miner

11 of some importance to my client, and I want to be as  
12 precise as we can about the evidence.

13 First of all, you yourself have no direct knowledge  
14 about what a continuous miner operator would do or not do  
15 with button, correct?

16 A. I don't have. I'm just going by the testimony I  
17 read.

18 Q. You have no direct knowledge and --

19 A. Except from the testimony that I read.

20 Q. No, just -- your answer is "yes," I take that. And  
21 in preparing for your testimony here, did you review the  
22 sworn testimony given by Bud Robinson?
