1 Q. That's fine.

2 A. I don't know if everyone does, but I do.

3 Q. And when you talked yesterday about the plywood  
4 barriers that were blocking off that abandoned section of  
5 the Southwest, were you aware of the evidence before the  
6 Inquiry that Mr. Phillips was told about the situation,  
7 about the leakage from that barrier, and that he himself  
8 promised to do something about it?

9 A. I guess there was a commitment that they would put  
10 permanent barriers in. But if you or I were down there  
11 and we found that gap, I'm sure we would have gone and  
12 got a piece of plywood and covered it up.

13 Q. That's not my question.

14 A. Well, that's what --

15 Q. My question is --

16 A. -- ordinary people --

17 Q. -- were you aware --

18 A. -- would do.

19 Q. -- of the testimony that Mr. Phillips was notified  
20 of that situation and that he himself promised to do  
21 something about it?

22 A. I read Jay Dooley's testimony and he said that Mr.  
23 Phillips agreed that they'd put a permanent stopping in  
24 and use it as a training session --
