

MR. CAMERON, EXAM. BY MR. ROBERTS

1 A. -- discredit; that's what it is.

2 MR. ROBERTS No, no --

3 MR. ENDRES Can I just make my point?

4 MR. ROBERTS -- with respect, the witness today --

5 A. I think --

6 COMMISSIONER One at a time, please, one at a time.

7 MR. ROBERTS At least --

8 MR. ENDRES Can I just make a point and then you can
9 react? I'm just wondering if it's part of the purpose of
10 the Inquiry to inquire into whether or not one person or
11 another gave away Cabinet secrets. I think that's what
12 my friend is after. What's the difference? What's it
13 got to do with the Inquiry?

14 MR. ROBERTS Could I respond to that?

15 COMMISSIONER Yeah.

16 MR. ROBERTS I'll respond two ways. First of all, the
17 witness has today, I counted three or four times, invoked
18 Cabinet secrecy as a reason for not answering questions
19 that were put to him by counsel. And secondly, this is a
20 conversation between Mr. Cameron and Mr. Phillips,
21 supposedly, about Cabinet matters --

22 COMMISSIONER As purported by --

23 MR. ROBERTS -- relating to Westray.

24 COMMISSIONER -- Phillips. My concern with this, Mr.
25 Roberts, and I expressed it yesterday to Mr. Merrick, is
