

MR. CAMERON, EXAM. BY MR. ROBERTS

1 that because some internal memorandum written by Mr.
2 Phillips, for his own people, for his own purposes,
3 becomes a record in this Inquiry, it seems to gain a
4 certain aura of respectability --

5 MR. ROBERTS It doesn't make it right.

6 COMMISSIONER -- and I can't accept that.

7 MR. ROBERTS I agree with you completely --

8 COMMISSIONER Yeah.

9 MR. ROBERTS -- Commissioner, and that's why I'm
10 putting it to this witness to have him confirm it or deny
11 it.

12 COMMISSIONER And he said several times, "Those are Mr.
13 Phillips' words."

14 MR. ROBERTS Okay.

15 COMMISSIONER You know. And I think that's -- as far as
16 I'm concerned, that puts a cap on it.

17 MR. ROBERTS Okay, fair enough.

18 COMMISSIONER Okay?

19 MR. ROBERTS I'll move on then, and I hesitate to, in
20 view of some of the questions asked earlier this
21 afternoon, enter this territory, but I do want to ask you
22 a couple of questions about the strip mine. You
23 testified yesterday that if Westray had been allowed to
24 mine the strip mine fully, that they never would have
25 been forced to go into the Southwest section. Do you
