- 8 A. Um-hmm.
- 9 Q. -- in developing the Foord seam. Are you familiar
- 10 with that letter?
- 11 A. I'm aware that that was done, yeah.
- 12 O. And we'll -- maybe we can look at that. That's in
- Exhibit 76, at tab 9.
- 14 A. And -- 76.
- 15 Q. Tab 9, beginning at the beginning of the tab, do you
- 16 see that?
- 17 A. Yes.
