- 1 MR. ENDRES Mr. Commissioner, can I interject --
- 2 MR. ROBERTS -- as a result of receiving this --
- 3 MR. ENDRES -- for a moment because what my friend
- 4 just said is quite wrong. We go to the previous page on
- 5 that, the last paragraph, it says clearly that Frame is
- 6 talking about "deep mines of the nature of the Pictou --
- 7 of Pictou are -- the risks are many." He's not talking
- 8 about Westray specifically --
- 9 MR. ROBERTS Mr. Commissioner --
- 10 MR. ENDRES -- he's talking about deep coal mines.
- 11 MR. ROBERTS -- this is cross-examination.
- 12 MR. ENDRES -- generically. Well, you've got to be
- 13 correct, though --
- 14 MR. ROBERTS I --
- 15 MR. ENDRES -- to cross-examine.
- 16 COMMISSIONER On top of page 44, Mr. Endres, it says:
- 17 "As Westray proceeds to move underground in the
- 18 development of this mine, we are prepared to cope with
- 19 the following problems."
- 20 MR. ENDRES Yes. But the previous paragraph he talks
- 21 about general deep coal mines --
- 22 COMMISSIONER Okay.
- 23 MR. ENDRES -- I want -- I think that's --
- 24 COMMISSIONER I'll take note of that.
