3 MR. MERRICK Over the noon break, Mr. Cameron, I was
4 reviewing our data base, and I came across some
5 correspondence back in 1988 that --

6 A. Where would I find this?

9 Q. -- let me give you what I can, and I'm going to ask
10 you if you recall it. In the latter part of 1988, this
11 was in a letter from Ken Streach to yourself, he
12 referred to the fact that Mr. Thomas Lynch of Lynch
13 Investments, had informed him that he had consultants
14 [sic] and discussions with people in New England about
15 the possibility of an existing coal market in the pulp
16 and paper industry down there. And he wanted to put
17 together a team from the Province of Nova Scotia with Tom
18 Lynch heading it up, and this consulting outfit, to carry
19 out a two-phased project with the objective of gaining
20 market shares for Nova Scotia coal in New England.

21 And he was writing to you. He says, "I am
22 personally supportive of this initiative and am writing
23 to you to seek support and funding, as I believe this
24 type of study falls within the mandate of your
25 department." Do you have any recollection of that?
