1 A. Just vaguely.

2 Q. Do you know if you supported that initiative to try
3 to find a market for coal that might have relieved the
4 Province from the need to become involved in take-or-pay
5 agreements?

6 A. My -- I don't believe we're just talking about
7 Westray coal. We're talking coal, period --

8 Q. You're right.

9 A. -- in Nova Scotia. DEVCO coal.

10 Q. You're right.

11 A. There was always this consideration that we could
12 find new markets for DEVCO coal if we blend it with the
13 low-sulphur coal. And we were always interested in
14 finding more new markets for their coal.

15 Q. Did you support that initiative?

16 A. I can't really answer that. I don't know if the
17 study was ever done. I'd have to go back to the
18 Department and see if they would provide that
19 information.

20 Q. All right. You have no recollection of whether it
21 was done or not done?

22 A. Not today, I can't --

23 Q. All right, thank you. I'll come to my second point,
